UPO invests in DC residents who develop their skills, gain jobs, and accelerate their earning power. They contribute to the economy and become self-sufficient as they build wealth and succeed.



EARLY CHILDCARE RETURNS

UPO is DC's largest Early Head Start provider. By removing the high cost of childcare, we enable parents to work and stimulate economic development at the community level. Young parents rely on our schools when starting a family after college or changing to a new career, and single mothers emerging from dependence on public support need this help while taking classes for the specialized training they need to succeed in high-demand jobs.
